Including the Foundation in Your Will

Some donors choose to establish a fund during their lifetime so they can benefit from actively participating in their grant making. Other donors establish a fund through a “bequest” to the Community Foundation, or through other methods of “deferred” giving. In order to include a charitable bequest in your will, your legal counsel may use language similar to this:

I give, devise and bequeath the following:

(Describe assets that are the subject of the bequest; for example, a stated sum or the residue of the estate, or a percentage of the residue of the estate.)

To the Community Foundation of Orange County, Inc. (d/b/a Community Foundation of Sullivan County), a nonprofit corporation within the State of New York.
